RULES FOR SPORT ACCURACY

1) COMPETITORS TO BE JUDGED ON THREE TASKS:

ACCURACY: The distance between their first point of contact and the target centre will be measured. Possible score of 0.00 metres (dead centre) to 15.00 metres maximum score.

STAND-UP LANDING: The jumper's ability to perform a stand-up landing. Failure to do a stand-up landing will add a 15.00 metre penalty to the competitor's score.

LANDING CONTROL: The jumper's ability to contain the complete landing from first point of contact to a full stop within a 15.00 metre radius circle. Failure to contain the landing within the 15.00 meter radius circle will add a 15.00 metre penalty to the competitor's score.

- 2) Maximum total score 45.00 metres.
- 3) The target dead center diameter will be as follows.

Round #1 1.50 metres (60 inches)

Round #2 0.40 metres (16 inches)

Round #3 0.03 metres (1.2 inches)
